



### Work Study (WS) Awarding Timeline for Students, 2019-2020

Below are key deadlines for the Work Study awarding process for the 2019-2020 academic year.

- Students must complete a free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by **April 15, 2019** to be eligible for a WS award for the 2019-20 year.
- Students will be awarded no later than April 31, 2019.
- Those students who are awarded the WS funding can begin applying for positions on **August 1, 2019** at [usu.joinhandshake.com/login](http://usu.joinhandshake.com/login).
- Students who have obtained WS positions may begin working on the first day of class which is August 26, 2019.
- Starting October 1, 2018 the 2019-20 FAFSA is available to complete at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). The 2019-20 FAFSA will use the 2017 tax/financial information.
- Please use the IRS Data Retrieval tool to transfer in your tax information directly from the IRS. Steps to transfer the information to the FAFSA are found at: <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa/filling-out#financial-info>.
- Please complete the 2019-20 FAFSA as soon as possible and remember to answer **“YES”** on the question asking if you are interested in being considered for work study.
